ROCKLIN, CA (August 14, 2019) - The Rocklin Unified School District Board of Trustees has a vacancy as of July 30, 2019. At their Regular Board Meeting on August 7, 2019, the Board decided to fill this vacancy by making a provisional appointment. The appointed applicant will serve as a member of the Board of Trustees through November 2020. The seat will be on the ballot* in the November 2020 election for the remaining two years of the four year term. The four year term ends December 2022.

Applications are now being accepted from any qualified person interested in filling this vacancy.

Legal qualifications for holding office are as follows:

- Applicant must be 18 years of age or older.
- Applicant must be a registered voter who is not disqualified by the Constitution or laws of the state from holding a civil office.
- Applicant must be a resident of the Rocklin Unified School District.
- Trustees cannot be an employee of the Rocklin Unified School District.

The Board of Trustees will interview candidates at a Special Board meeting September 18, 2019.
