Dear Parents/Guardians of Victory High School Students:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you about our school's accountability status under the Elementary & Secondary Education Act. Under this law, all schools must show academic growth each year in English language arts and mathematics as measured by California's statewide assessments. Not only does the overall school have to demonstrate improvement, but additionally, so does every student group in the school. These include economically disadvantaged students, students with special needs, and students learning English, to name a few.

While Victory High School has performed very well and currently has an Academic Performance Index of 702, school wide we did not meet our growth target in English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics for two consecutive years. As a result, our school continues to be identified as a Program Improvement (PI) School. We are now in year 2 of Program Improvement. Every effort is being made and will continue to be made to ensure that all children reach high levels of academic success.

As a parent/guardian of a student in a PI school you have the option to request Supplemental Educational Services (SES). These services include tutoring, which occurs outside the regular school day with educational providers approved by the California State Board of Education. **If the number of eligible students who apply for the SES program exceeds the financial resources available, the lowest achieving students from low-income families will receive SES first.**

SES providers may only be selected during one of the two windows September 17 – September 30 or December 3 - December 16. If you are interested in SES, please visit your child's school office for the "Parent Request for Supplemental Services Form" and /or to see the list of providers willing to serve the district.
