ARTICLE 6
HOLIDAYS

6.1 Paid Holidays

The District agrees to provide unit employees with the following paid holidays:

New Year's Day	January 1
Martin Luther King's Birthday	Third Monday in January (Jan. 21)
President's Day	In lieu of Washington's Birthday (Feb 18)
President's Day	In lieu of Lincoln's Birthday (Feb. 22)
Memorial Day	Last Monday in May (May 27)
Independence Day	July 4
Labor Day	First Monday in September (Sept. 3)
Veteran's Day	In lieu of Veteran's Day (Nov 12)
Thanksgiving Day	The Thursday proclaimed by the President (Nov. 22)
In lieu of Admissions Day	Friday following Thanksgiving (Nov. 23)
Christmas Day	December 25

Eligible twelve (12) month employees will receive the following paid holidays:

<u>Holiday</u>	<u>Date Approved</u>
Full Day on Christmas Eve	(effective 1/1/94)
Full Day on New Year's Eve	(effective 1/1/94)
Full Day on the Friday of spring break	(effective 7/1/09)*

Every Leap Year, a (non-work/non-paid) day off will be awarded to twelve month employees between December 25 and January 1.

**This full day will settle any and all disputes in regard to the number of work days (260 vs. 261) for twelve month employees.*

6.2 Eligibility for Paid Status

In order to be eligible to be paid for a holiday, an employee must be in paid status on the working day immediately preceding or succeeding that holiday.
