Fever (>100.4) or chills	Muscle or body aches	Sore throat	Difficulty breathing New confusion/delirium Bluish lips or face Persistent chest pain or pressure
Cough	Headache	Nausea	
Chills	New loss of taste or smell	Vomiting	
Fatigue	Congestion or runny nose	Diarrhea	

State Guidelines for schools, state district or individual school closure is recommended based on the number of cases, the percentage of teachers/students/staff that are positive for COVID-19, and following consultation with the Local Health Officer. Individual school closures may be appropriate when there are multiple cases in multiple cohorts at a school or when at least 5 percent of the total number of students & staff are infected or potentially infected in a 14 day time period.

One or more symptom of COVID-19 - which cannot be explained with documentation from a physician

Exclude from school for 10 days from symptom onset. May not return to school until 24 hours after symptoms resolve without fever-reducing medication.*

Recommend testing - a COVID-19 test may shorten the 10-day exclusion.

Close Contact with a Positive COVID-19 Test

Exclude for 14 days from last exposure.*

Recommend testing - a negative test will not shorten the 14-day quarantine.

Positive COVID-19 Test

Exclude from school for 10 days from symptom onset or test date. May not return to school until 24 hours after symptoms resolve without fever-reducing medication.*

Negative COVID-19 Test

Exclude from school. May return to school 72 hours after symptoms resolve without fever-reducing medication.*

Symptoms - No Test

Exclude from school for 10 days from symptom onset. May not return to school until 24 hours after symptoms resolve without fever-reducing medication.*
