Since my last email about delaying our schools reopening, Placer County Public Health (PCPH) clarified that they had discussed the risks of reopening without adequate testing in place, but did not issue a mandate. I took seriously the risk they raised, but I realize this back and forth is confusing and I apologize for any misunderstanding this has caused.

Bottom line: Having access to timely COVID-19 testing and results is essential to limiting the spread of COVID-19 and keeping schools open. Until we are able to meet these safety precautions, we will remain in distance learning for the time being. We are also working with PCPH to increase testing for schools. I will let you know as soon as we have information to share. We will continue to communicate updates to families via email.
