

Update: Rocklin Unified School District Board of Trustees Meeting

December 15, 2020

The Rocklin Unified School District Board of Trustees voted to begin AM/PM instruction, five days a week for all schools starting on January 19, 2021. Students will be assigned to either the AM or PM group to maintain classrooms and campuses within our current social distancing practices.

- Elementary students will receive their schedules from their school sites by December 18, 2020.
- Middle school students will receive schedule information from their school sites by December 18, 2020.
- High school students will receive their updated schedules by January 8, 2021.
- Special Education Preschool and Adult Transition will continue with their current schedule but may have extended hours. Any program schedule changes for special education will be shared by individual case managers by January 8, 2021.

The Board also voted to resume full time 5 days a week instruction at all schools after Spring Break on April 6, 2021 with the option to do so earlier if Placer County moves to the orange tier cited from the Blueprint for a Safer Economy.

The Rocklin Virtual Campus (RVC) is not impacted by these decisions and will continue to serve students who enrolled earlier this year. Inquiries regarding RVC enrollment should be directed to your student's traditional school.

The RUSD Board of Trustees weighed all options in front of them. These decisions, like many during this COVID-19 pandemic, are complex and without easy solutions. We thank those who provided their input which allowed our Board to make an informed decision.
