Disclosure of Student Information 2017-2018

The District will, at times, release student information to outside organizations/vendors, for specific limited purposes, and with the required safeguards for confidentiality and information security, as required by Education Code §49073 §49076 , the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 2001 (20 U.S.C. Sec.1232g), state law, and Board Policy. Such purposes include: developing, validating or administering tests; administering student aid programs; and improving instruction. Examples of specific purposes include: demographic projections for budgeting and proper staffing, services that clearly enhance the educational/school experience such as yearbook, photography, academic assessments, electronic course delivery, supplemental curriculum/materials, college and career planning and recruiting, electronic transcript services, financial assistance programs, nutrition services, and collecting on-line payments and processing, etc. Specific student information/data includes, but may not be limited to: Student identification number, name, grade level, program status/participation, course completion, and ethnicity. The outside organization/vendor will give written assurance that the pupil-related information it receives from the school district shall be destroyed/deleted when no longer needed for the purposes for which it was obtained, AND the organization and all of its employees/representatives will not permit access to any student information/records by any other persons, agency or organization, except as allowed under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 2001 (20 U.S.C. Sec.1232g) and state law, without written consent of the student's parent/guardian.
