

COVID-19 Update - RUSD Schools Cleaned on March 4: March 5, 2020

RUSD Families and Staff:

Based on updated information, we want to supplement the statement RUSD sent on March 4 at 7 p.m. We want to provide you with the most accurate news regarding the coronavirus, now called COVID-19. Yesterday, we sent out a note to all RUSD families and staff regarding students and staff at 4 of our schools connected to Rocklin Firefighters who may have been exposed to COVID-19. We have received new facts that 2 of the schools originally reported, Sunset Ranch Elementary and Granite Oaks Middle School, are not affected.

As you know, we have taken additional precautions and cleaned 4 schools last night. Granite Oaks Middle School and Sunset Ranch Elementary were also cleaned but at this time we know of no connection to COVID-19. Again, yesterday we immediately connected with Placer County Public Health officials who informed us there is no threat to our students or staff.

We would also like to take this time to remember that during these times of potential crisis, we are thankful for our local emergency responders who keep us safe from harm in all kinds of situations. For that reason, we want to remind you that all official information about any connection to our Rocklin Unified schools comes from our school district. This is a time for our Rocklin community to come together and recognize the life-saving work our public servant heroes perform day in and day out.
