## SUPERINTENDENT'S NOTE

Dear Families and Staff of Rocklin Unified,

As the COVID-19 outbreak continues to evolve, our school district remains diligent in our efforts to provide families with essential services, support student wellness and ensure continuity of our students' education. We have a few updates for you:

- START OF THE 2020-2021 SCHOOL YEAR: The 2020-2021 school year start date for the Rocklin Unified School District is Wednesday, August 12 as previously scheduled.
  - Each day, we continue the process of creating a plan for how schools will address the needs
    of students next school year. The District has been actively working with our labor partners
    and others to begin thinking and collaborating on different scenarios under which the 20202021 school year may begin.
  - Our goal is to fully reopen our schools with all students on campus in August. We are continuing to plan for this and will continue to monitor public health guidance/regulations related to school reopening.
  - If the district is not able to fully reopen with all of our students on campus at one time due to
    public health guidance/regulations then the District is working with our labor partners to plan
    for a hybrid scenario that would provide high-quality ongoing education with less students
    on campus each day. For example, an alternating day schedule with online and on-campus
    attendance.
  - A full RUSD online option will be provided for families that prefer to have that option and still stay part of RUSD. This new model will include grading. Additional details will be provided soon.
  - As we continue to prepare for the upcoming school year, we want to hear your feedback regarding your family's online learning experience! Your opinion on Rocklin Unified's transition from traditional in-person education is very important to us during this planning process. We are still accepting submissions to our Online Learning Survey, now through 5 p.m. on Thursday, May 28 at https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/RUSDonline520.

An ongoing challenge is that circumstances and guidance are in a continual state of change which makes planning difficult. We will continue to update you on our plans for the 2020-2021 school year. The Board of Trustees is planning to make a decision on how schools reopen at a special Board meeting this July. They will be reviewing the latest public health guidance/regulations, the local context of other schools, and updated options.

 Ask RUSD - STUDENT WELLNESS: I am excited to announce the second event of our Ask RUSD series, this time focused on Student social and emotional wellness that may be affected by the COVID-19 pandemic. We have invited a group of expert panelists to join us tonight, Wednesday, May 27 from 5:30 - 6:30 p.m. to discuss this subject and answer any questions you may have about your student's wellness during this time.



Our second Ask RUSD event will feature district experts, as well as our partners, who will discuss student wellness and answer your questions about the affect the COVID-19 crisis may have on your child.
