
Transitional Kindergarten, Extended Day Kindergarten and Full Day Kindergarten

1. All Transitional Kindergarten teachers, herein referred to as TK, Extended Day Kindergarten teachers, herein referred to as EDK, will have prep time equal to that of teachers in Grades 1-6. The preparation time will be held after the release of students as long as the TK and EDK program is an extended day, in lieu of kindergarten prep time in Article VIII.1(c). If TK and/or EDK moves to full day, the TK and/or EDK teacher will have prep time equal to that of teachers in Grades 1-6 and will be in the same format provided for in Article VIII.1. Every effort will be made to allow the TK and/or EDK teacher to have their room during their preparation time.
2. All Full Day Kindergarten teachers will have prep time equal to that of teachers in Grades 1-6 and will be in the same format provided for in Article VIII.1, in lieu of kindergarten prep time in Article VIII.1(c). Every effort will be made to allow the kindergarten teacher to have their room during their preparation time.
3. In collaboration with the site administrator and all K teachers at the site, the TK and EDK teachers may be assigned, and shall develop a plan, to intervene or enrich students within their own grade level to include, TK, EDK, or Full Day K.
4. TK, EDK and K teachers shall be assigned a similar duty, schedule/assignment, equivalent to that of teachers in Grades 1-3 at the site.
5. TK, EDK and K teachers shall have the support of an instructional aide for at least 30 minutes per day (or the weekly equivalent as per the needs of the TK, EDK or K teacher) to be used for direct impact on student learning. Site Administrators will be encouraged to extend this instructional support time. Instructional support time shall be scheduled in collaboration with the TK, EDK and K teachers.
6. This MOU is in effect for the 2015-2016 school year only unless the parties mutually agree to extend. This MOU does modify Article VIII. 1(c) for the duration of the MOU. This MOU does not otherwise modify, replace, or eliminate Article VII.
