As we welcome students back to campus, below are a few updates that will help to prepare for a smooth transition.

- **Student Health Screening:** Before coming to campus, we ask parents/caregivers to use the screening questions referenced in the RUSD School Reopening Guidance document (linked here) on page 10.
- Face coverings: Face coverings must be used in accordance with <u>CDPH guidelines</u>, particularly in indoor environments, on school buses, and areas where physical distancing alone is not sufficient to prevent disease transmission. Please see more details here.
- What happens if a student or staff has symptoms or tests positive with COVID-19? RUSD will follow Placer County Public Health and Placer County Office of Education current recommendations outlined here. - Talk with your kids: Please remind your kids to talk with you if they don't feel well.
 Also please remind them about the importance of hand washing, physical distancing and wearing required face coverings. This is not going "back to school" in a way we ever imagined, so it's very important that we all use extra patience, kindness and respect.
